

INTRODUCTION

The Tax Administration Code of the City of Woodland Park is designed to provide citizens with a reference guide to requirements regarding collection of sales and use tax and to implement a uniform system of collection in the City of Woodland Park that is complementary to the State system.

The Code is designed to be consistent with Colorado law and regulations as well as with practices of other municipalities that have elected to collect sales and use tax. It is hoped this will be a convenience for merchants conducting business in multiple jurisdictions.

No one section of the Code states the law applicable to a particular situation. The Code must be read and interpreted as a whole, taking into account applicable statutes and judicial decisions.

However, there will be some variance from models utilized by other entities to allow conformance with the requirements of the Woodland Park City Charter.
