Sidewalk or Sandwich Board Signs located in the right-of-way shall be removed during non-business hours and/or during periods of snow removal, shall leave a minimum of 3 feet of unobstructed pedestrian access on the sidewalk and cannot cause the pedestrian to move closer to the road. Place sign on splash pad.
